

6.01 Curriculum Policy

1. Rationale

Curriculum refers to the knowledge, skills, and attitudes which are to be developed in children at specific grade levels and the materials which are to be used to do it. Kootenay Christian Academy, as an accredited independent school in the Province of British Columbia, follows the BC Ed Plan. While fulfilling Ministry of Education requirements, all courses, curriculum and teaching are delivered from a Christian worldview and perspective.

2. Policy

- 2.1. The curriculum for KCA will be the British Columbia Ed Plan.
- 2.2. The curriculum will be taught by Christian teachers using materials that are written from a Christian perspective wherever possible. (see Learning Resources Policy)
- 2.3. The curriculum will be presented through a variety of methodologies in accordance with sound educational practice according to the BC Ministry of Education. Administration and Staff are to consider the needs of individual students and work with them to meet the expectation of the personalized learning educational program, wherever appropriate.
- 2.4. The Administration and Staff will develop a curriculum for each core subject including the scope and sequence, resources, and recommended teaching strategies appropriate for each grade which reflects the requirements of the province as adapted to meet the priorities of the school.
- 2.5. The Administration will ensure that the curriculum is reviewed and revised on a regular basis so that the entire curriculum is reviewed over a five year period. (See Program Evaluation Policy)
