6.21 School Completion (Evergreen) Certificate

1. Rationale

The school is responsible for providing educational programs to students with special needs who are on an Individualized Education Program (IEP). The School Completion Certificate, or Evergreen Certificate, is intended to celebrate success in learning and accomplishments of students with diverse abilities or disabilities (special needs). To be eligible for a School Completion Certificate, the student must be designated in one of the Inclusive Education categories and have an IEP with modified curriculum. The decision to place a student in an Evergreen Program should not be made prior to Grade 10. Before a student is placed on a School Completion Program, the Principal will consult with parent(s)/guardian(s) and, where possible, the student to ensure the appropriateness of the program. The principal will ensure the parent(s)/guardian(s) are aware that this pathway will not meet the criteria for a BC Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma) and Kootenay Christian Academy's Parent Acknowledgment of Program Modification form has been signed.
